Visit the Biography Center in *Student* or *Important People in Kids* to search for specific people or browse Hispanic Americans.



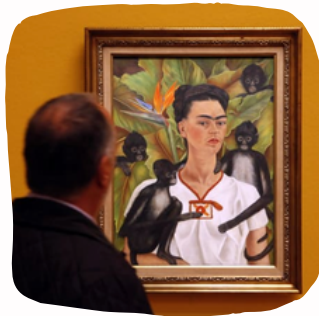
Search for content in *Kids*, *Student*, *Advanced*, and *Discover*.
